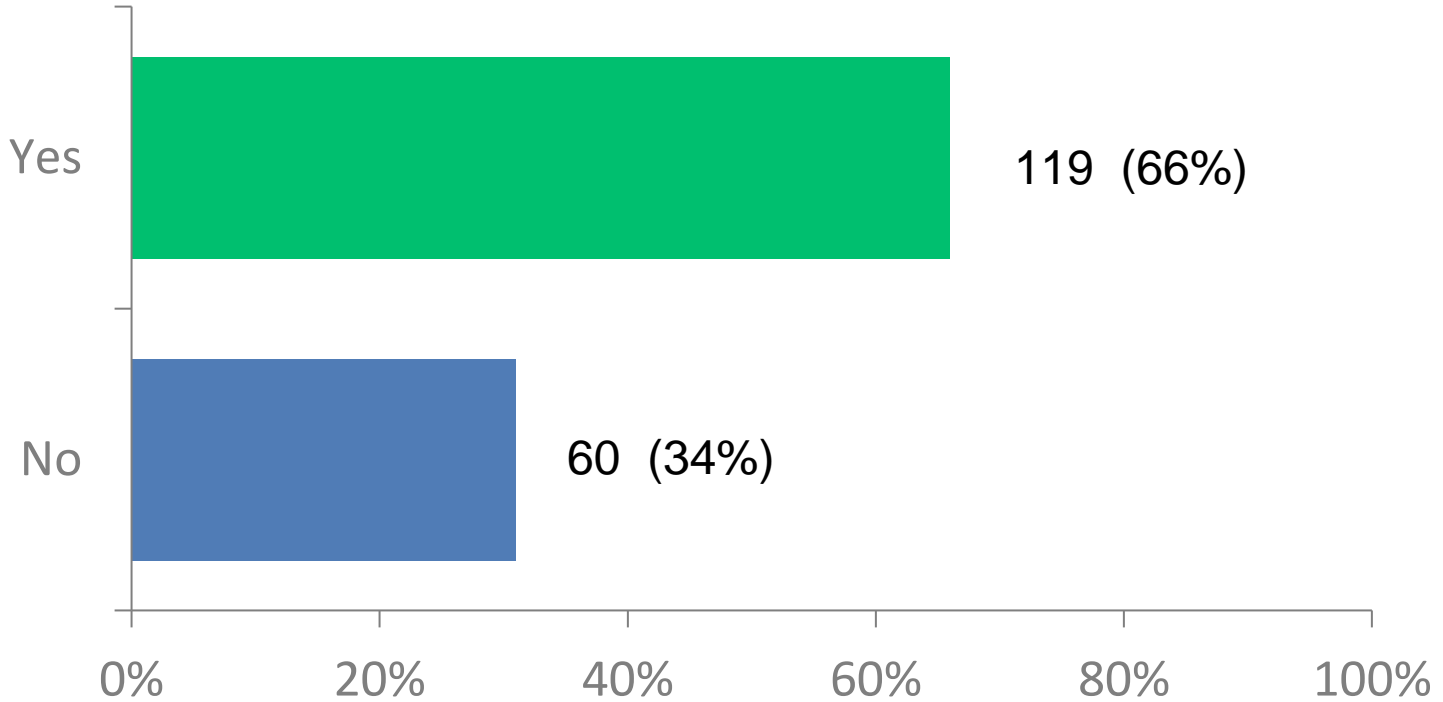

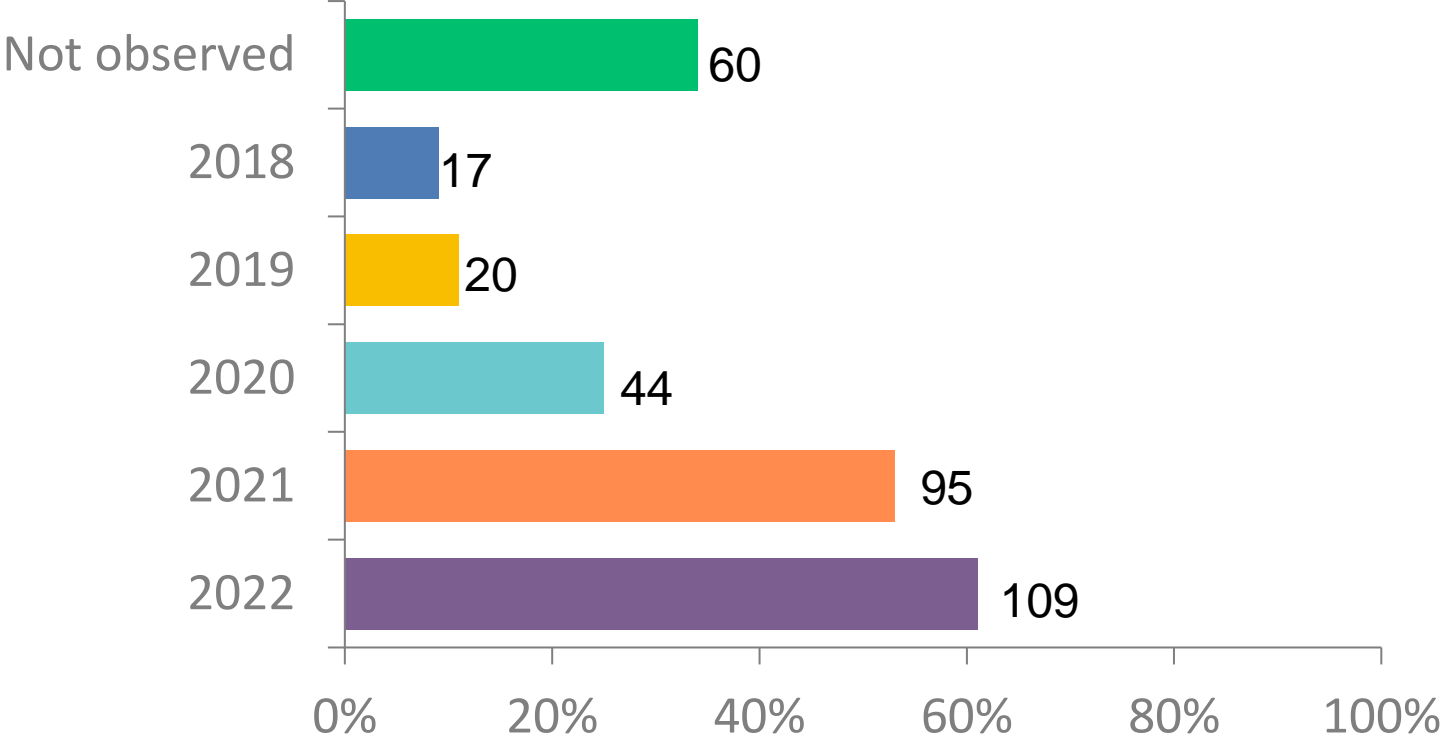

Q2: Have you observed any large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots in the corpses you have embalmed?

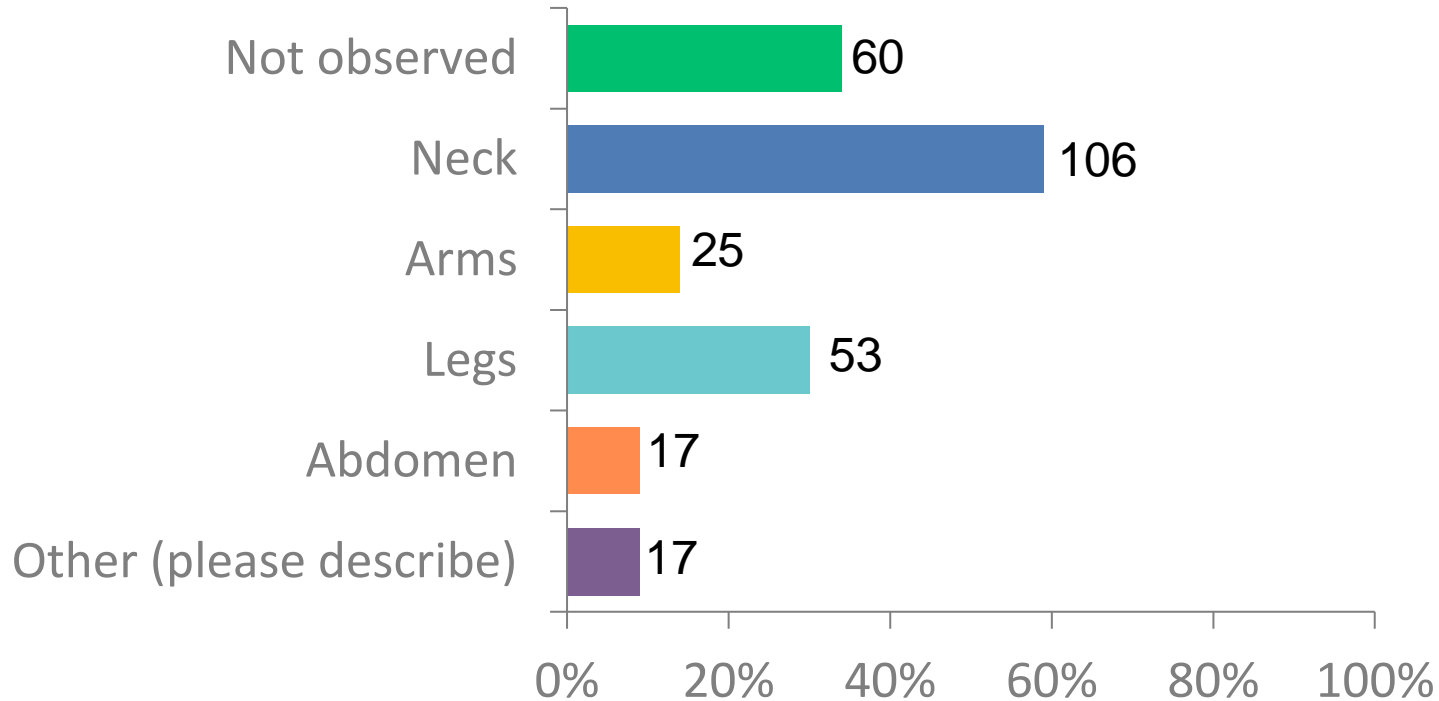

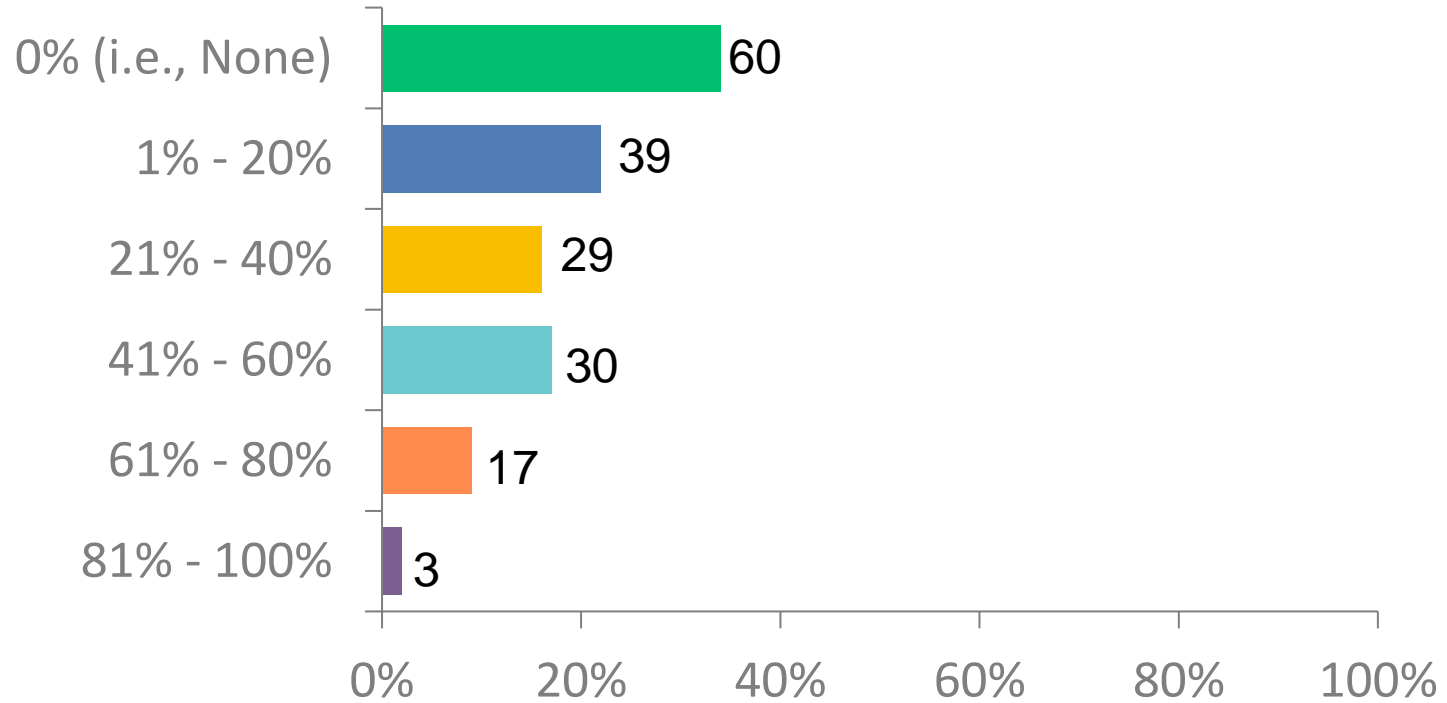
Q3: What years have you observed the large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots? (Please check ALL years that apply. Select "Not observed" if you have not observed any.)



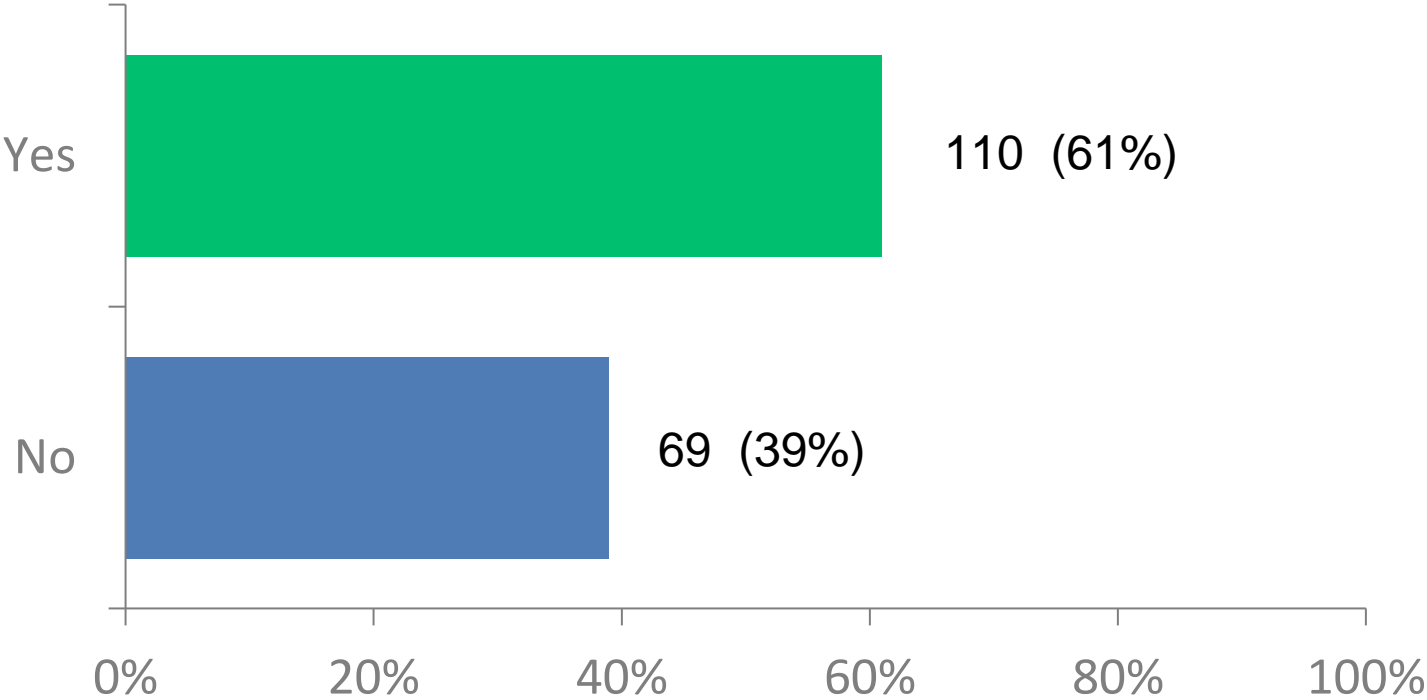
Q4: Where have you observed the large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots? (Please check ALL areas that apply. Select "Not observed" if you have not observed any.)



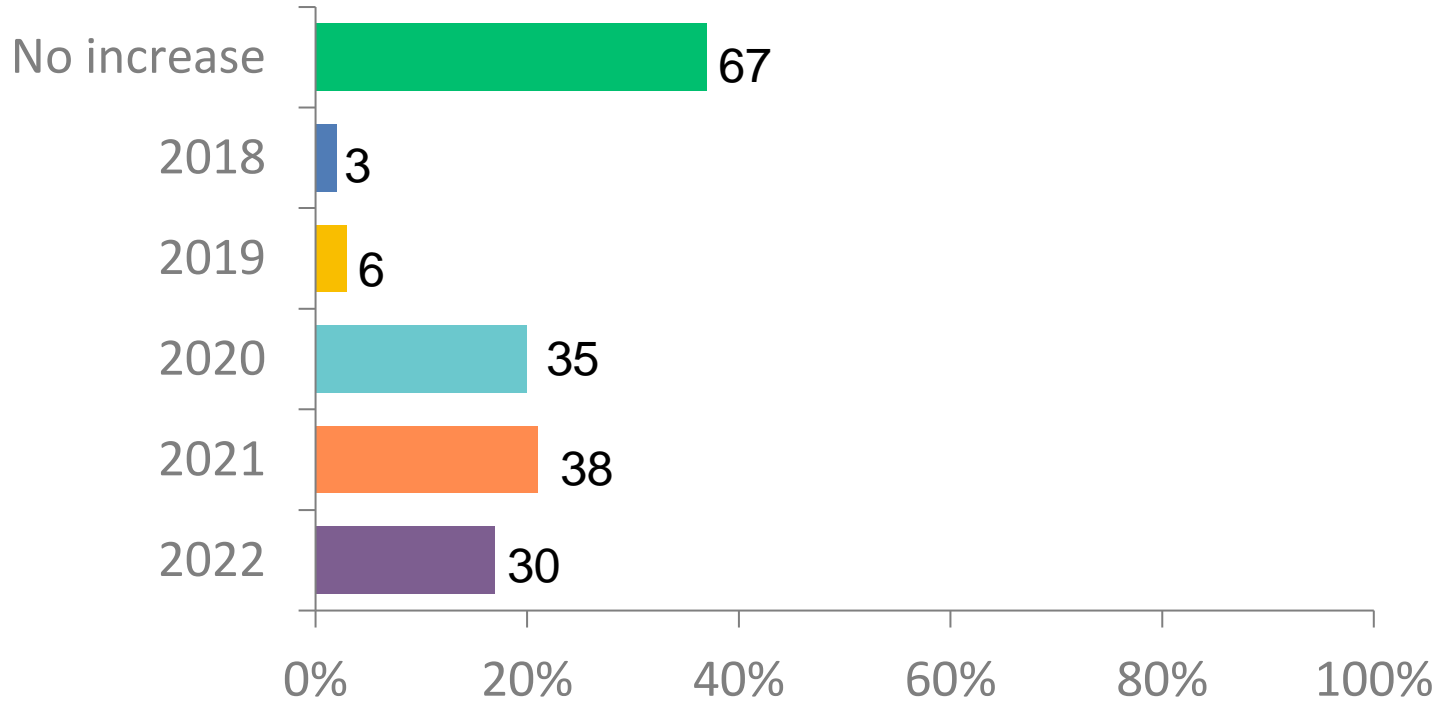
Q5: What percentage of the corpses in the Year 2022 that you have embalmed have had the large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots? (Please select only one answer.)

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- 2 out of every 3 embalmers are seeing these unusual “white fibrous clots” in veins and arteries of corpses
- Main consensus is that these “white fibrous clots” first appeared in Year 2021 and continued into Year 2022 (after the rollout of the COVID-19 vaccines)
 - Although some embalmers say this started in Year 2020
 - Latest survey data shows clots continuing into 2023 as well
- Embalmers are seeing these clots in a significant percentage of corpses (up to 50% or more in some cases!)
- FDA and CDC need to immediately investigate to see if the COVID-19 vaccines could be causing these clots
